

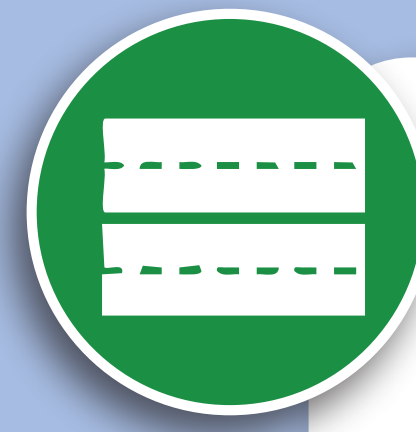

We received numerous comments through the online commenting map, virtual public meeting, stakeholder coordination, and written comments. Some of the most common themes are summarized below.



“ More accessible facilities for cyclists and pedestrians are needed. ”



“ We need more parallel routes between Belgrade and Bozeman, Jackrabbit and Huffine are too busy. ”



“ The lack of shoulders on county roads is dangerous, especially in the winter. ”



“ We need more law enforcement to ticket drivers who are speeding, distracted, and impaired. ”



“ Expanding public transportation services into the county would be beneficial for rural residents. ”



“ Potholes, faded striping, inadequate signage, and overgrown vegetation contribute to crashes and hazardous driving conditions. ”



“ More wildlife crossings are needed, especially on US 191. ”



“ Lowering speed limits could help reduce crashes and improve overall safety. ”



“ It is difficult to turn onto major roads with high traffic volumes and speeds from minor streets/driveways. ”



“ Too many drivers are on their cell phones and distracted. ”
