

Gallatin County Resolution No. 2025- 045

TO ADOPT THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL ACTION PLAN

This resolution was introduced by Cola Rowley, moved by Commissioner MacFarlane, seconded by Commissioner Brown, and approved by a vote 3 in favor and 0 opposed on June 17, 2025.

WHEREAS, in 2024, Gallatin County was awarded a Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning Grant from the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT); and

WHEREAS, staff and the consultants, Robert Peccia and Associates, developed the Gallatin County Safe Streets for All Action Plan as a continued effort working toward creating a safer transportation system across Gallatin County; and

WHEREAS, a draft Gallatin County Safe Streets for All Action Plan, attached hereto and incorporated fully herein by this reference, has been prepared for the purpose of establishing visions and goals for transportation safety, identifying high-crash, and high-risk focus areas of the transportation system through data analysis and community input; and

WHEREAS, adopting the Gallatin County Safe Streets for All Action Plan will enable the County to apply for future grant funds under the Safe Streets For All program for project implementation as needed to fulfill the identified needs of the plan; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on June 3, 2025, at which the County Commission passed unanimously a resolution of intent to adopt the Gallatin County Safe Streets for All Action Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission adopts the Gallatin County Safe Streets for All Action Plan.
